Newlyn October 2007 - Programme Notes

Bombrassa Marching Band Following the Kneehigh Theatre's highly acclaimed "An Old Man with Enormous Wings", composers Jim Carey and Adrian Freedman were asked to present similar music for entertainment at Eden in 2005. Brief: the band had to be mobile, and loud enough to play without a sound system. *Bombrassa*- up to nine brass and two drummers- was the result. Several members of the band live in Newlyn. The band has wowed Mazey Day two years running, and recently, the Port Elliot literary festival. They'll be marching through Newlyn from noon on **Saturday 13th** to the **Ripple's** berth at **the Old Quay**, and then on to **Gwavas playing field** in conjunction with:

Skylarks "Writing in the Air" Paul Antonelli presents a giant aerial sculpture to be launched & flown from **Gwavas playing field**, A festival skyline signature visible in the harbour & across Mounts Bay. With "**Overload**" dancers aged 7-16 led by Jen Lawry (3 Villages Project) -& music from **Bombrassa**. **2pm Saturday 13th**

Show of work by Local Artists- "Newlyn Contemporary" Newlyn's vibrant fishing industry has always attracted artists. Today, a large number of artists still live and work in the village, and form an increasingly important part of the local economy. The Festival presents an open show of their work in The Centre, **Saturday 13th -Sunday 14th**. **Meet the artists 1.30pm Sunday 14th**. **Sculptors** will be exhibiting in Tolcarne Motors showroom. St Peter's Hall (Newlyn Combe) will host **local photographers, Friday 12th to Sunday 14th (Call Maggie 350526)**

The Ripple & The Rosebud - "A tale of two boats." In 1937 part of the village was threatened with demolition by Penzance council's "slum clearance" programme- the villagers protested by sending the MFV "Rosebud" on a voyage to the Houses of Parliament at Westminster. We commemorate the *Rosebud* this weekend, exactly 70 years since she set sail. For several years John Lambourn has been restoring a sailing lugger, *The Ripple*: as the Festival begins on **Friday 12th** she will be launched during the morning, mooring at the Old Quay. she will be blessed by the Rev. Julyan Drew plus the Male Choir- **4.30pm on Sunday 14th Old Quay**.

Exhibition of photographs of the *Rosebud* action opens at The Centre, **Saturday 6th till Sunday 14th**.

DRAMA "Daphne is Dancing" Glastonbury festival: a woman nearing 30 has pitched up at Worthy Farm and finds herself looking back at her early experiences with the opposite sex, booze, drugs etc. For the last few years she's been leading a "normal life" with a nice but dull partner: is there more to life than that? Is there still time left to be a bit wilder? Kate Morris explores this scenario in her 45 minute monologue, a show that she has taken to the Edinburgh Fringe. **Sat 13th 6-7pm NAG Studio**

DRAMA "Art" (translation by Christopher Hampton.) Serge has bought a work of art; it's a 5' by 4' canvas painted white, apparently with some diagonal white lines running across it that may or may not be visible according to the viewing angle or the quality of light falling on the work. Price: 200,000 francs. This play by French writer Yasmina Reza examines the impact of Serge's purchase on the dynamic of his relationship with his two closest friends. Produced at Wyndham's Theatre in 1996, voted drama of the year by the London Evening Standard... presented here as a rehearsed reading by Phil Bowen, Anthony Frost and Bob Devereux. A café-style event; drinks & finger-food will be available & the audience is invited to stay on for live **Jazz**. **Sunday 14th 6.30-8pm St Peter's Hall.**

The Tolcarne Jazz Quartet Alan Thompson's guitar playing combines authority with taste and sensitivity; known locally for his Sunday Jazz sessions at the Tolcarne Inn. For this gig he's joined by Marc Hadley (sax) who also lives in Newlyn, Peter Kubryk-Townsend (bass) and Damian Rodd (drums.) All highly-rated players in Cornwall and beyond; expect to be swayed, moved and challenged. **Free: 8pm, Sunday 14th** after the reading of "Art".

Newlyn Male Choir This 24-strong group sing both secular and religious music to the highest standard; a not-to-be-missed opportunity, as the collective sound of these men is spine-tingling in its intensity and beauty; the acoustic of the Centre adds to the experience. **Friday 12th 8pm** at The Centre.
